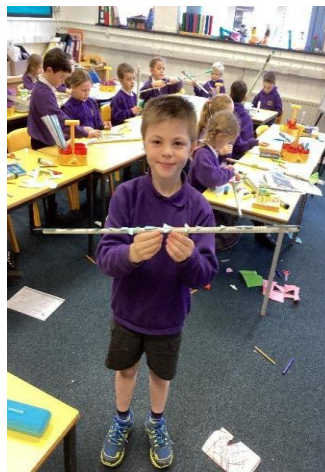
Carleton School House Captains

Height and weight checks for children in Reception and Year 6

Every year in England, school children in reception and year 6 have their height and weight checked at school as part of the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP). Height and weight measurements are used to calculate weight status. This information is collected to build a picture of how children are growing to help plan better health and leisure services for families.

All parents of children in reception and Year 6 should have received a letter about this earlier in the week. If you are happy for your child to be measured, you do not need to do anything. If you do not want your child's height and weight to be measured you will need to **opt out** using the details in the letter. Please contact the school office if you need more information.
