

Dear parents and carers

National Measles Incident - 'THINK' Measles

Further to the information in last week's newsletter please be aware of the following information sent on behalf of North Yorkshire Council's Director of public health

Please note the following are symptoms of Measles:

• Usually starts with cold-like symptoms

- High fever
- Sore red watery eyes
- Cough and/or runny nose
- Small red spots with bluish-white centres inside the mouth
- A red/brown blotchy rash which appears several days later, rough to the touch.

You should keep your child away from school for at least 4 days from when the rash first appeared and until they are completely recovered.

Keep your child away from babies, anyone who is pregnant and those with a weakened immune system.
