Year 1 Autumn Term 2 Curriculum Map 2023

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	<p>The key text we will be looking at is 'The Queen's Hat' by Steve Anthony and working on an independent writing piece based on this text. We will be working on our understanding of sentence structure and developing a rich vocabulary to write effective and exciting sentences.</p> <p>For our non-fiction unit we are focusing on poetry and developing an appreciation and understanding of poetry structure.</p>
Maths	<p>In Maths we are focusing on addition and subtraction. Children will develop their confidence in addition and subtraction within 10 and then moving on to different methods such as part whole models, number lines and fact families. Children will learn about the mathematical symbols and what they mean.</p>
Science	<p>In science we are learning about the seasons. We will look at the season cycle and learn the names of the seasons. We will explore the different weather and the changes that occur in each season.</p>
History	<p>In History we are focusing on famous queens. We are going to be learning about what a monarch is and where they live. We will be exploring different famous queens and what life was like in the time period that they reigned.</p>
DT	<p>In DT we are going to focus on structures and working towards constructing a windmill. We will make stable structures, which will eventually support the turbine, out of card, tape and glue and make functioning turbines and axles that are assembled into the main supporting structure.</p>
Music	<p>For music this half term we will be taking part in the nativity production where we will practice singing and playing percussion instruments.</p>
P.E.	<p>In PE we will be developing our gymnastic skills including physical aspects such as travelling actions, shapes, balances, shape jumps, barrel roll, straight roll and forward rolls. Social and emotional aspects such as respect, collaboration, sharing, work safely, confidence, self-regulation and perseverance.</p> <p>We will also be developing our ball skills such as dribbling with hands, roll, throw, catch, dribble with feet, track as well as communication, supporting others and co-operation skills.</p>
R.E.	<p>Our topic in RE this half term focuses on the big question 'why does Christmas matter to Christians?' We will explore the story of Jesus's birth and think about ways in which Christians celebrate this today. We will also think about how Christians use the nativity story to guide their beliefs and actions at Christmas.</p>

P.S.H.E	In PSHE we are learning about celebrating differences and how our differences make us all unique and special. We will focus on the importance of being kind to others and accepting others differences. We will discuss how we can include others and what we can do to help someone who is being treated unfairly.
Computing	In computing we are going to be learning how to create pictograms to record data from an experiment. We will learn how to program a computer to follow simple instructions and learn how to debug errors.
