## Year 2 Autumn Term 2 Curriculum Map 2023

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	Our writing this half term will be based on 'My Christmas Star'. We will follow the Jane Considine writing scheme to write effective sentences, using imagination days and plot points to help us. For our independent write at the end of this unit, we will re-tell the story.
Maths	In this unit, addition and subtraction, children will learn how to add and subtract numbers within 100. They will learn how to add by making a ten first and will also learn how to add and subtract whilst crossing the tens. For example, what to do when we add 12 and 19.
Science	In this unit of work pupils will observe the changes across the four seasons. They will complete practical investigative work to explore how the weather changes with the seasons and how the change in weather then causes many other changes to occur. Pupils will also find out how in the UK the day length is longer in summer and shorter in winter.
History	In this unit of work, pupils will learn all about the famous figure Guy Fawkes and the key events of the Gunpowder Plot. They will find out about what life was like for Catholics in living England under the reign of King James 1, who Guy Fawkes was and why Bonfire Night is celebrated.
DT	In this unit of work, pupils will extend their knowledge of shapes to help them create a structure that will hold. They will also experiment with different types of structures and their features to help them build their final product for testing. Next, they will explore clay and its properties to make pots and tiles using an assortment of techniques.
Music	Pupils will be learning a song called the 'Ho Ho Ho by Joanna Mangona. It is a song with rapping and improvising for Christmas. They will practise singing the song and use instruments to create compositions to perform with the song.
P.E.	This half term we shall be developing ball skills and gymnastics in P.E.
R.E.	In this unit of work pupils will learn that Christians believe Jesus brings good news for all people. They will think about how for Christians, this good news includes being loved by God, and being forgiven for bad things. They will explore stories from the Bible and look at how Christians believe Jesus is friend to the poor and the friendless and how his teachings guide the beliefs Christians have about prayer, in their church communities and their own lives.

<b>P.S.H.E</b>	In this unit of work pupils will work through a series of lessons in order to celebrate the importance of being unique and show respect for similarity and difference. They will learn that everyone is different and unique and that is ok. Pupils will then think about the issue of bullying, why this happens and what to do if someone is being bullied. Through circle time games and exploring different scenarios they will understand how it feels to be a friend and to have a friend.
<b>Computing</b>	This term, children will be learning how to use the internet safely and will continue to develop their coding skills.
