Year 4 Summer Term 1 Curriculum Map 2024

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	We will be by retelling the story Aladdin and the Enchanted Lamp , as retold by Philip Pullman, focusing on using powerful vocabulary and a range of sentence structures and language features. We will then write our own narratives inspired by the story. Next, inspired by our Geography topic, we will write persuasive holiday brochures encouraging people to visit the Americas.
Maths	We be working on Fractions and Decimals this half term. We will begin by adding and subtracting fractions, before focusing on tenths and hundredths, and building our understanding of what these numbers mean. We will learn how to divide a number by 10 or 100 to make it a decimal number.
Science	This half term, we'll be focusing on our experimental skills and Working Scientifically . We will plan and carry out investigations and record our results in a range of ways, drawing on the topics we've already learned so far this year.
Geography	We will be studying The Americas this half term. We will learn about the major geographical regions of North and South America, and learn to locate key countries and cities on the map. We will compare the cities of New York and Buenos Aires, to get an idea what it might be like to live in the Americas.
Art	This half term, we'll be completing a craft and design project using Glue Batik , based on the concept 'The Fabric of Nature', and inspired by the designs of William Morris.
Music	We will be continuing to improve our skills in singing, playing the glockenspiel, composing and improvising, this time using the Beatles song Blackbird as our focus.
P.E	This half term we'll be continuing to work with Skipton Tennis and Kanga working on ball skills and technique for Tennis.
R.E	This half term we'll be considering the question What are the deeper meanings of festivals? We will look at a range of festivals from different religions, including Eid-ul-Fitr, Pesach (Passover) and Diwali.
P.S.H.E	Our topic this half term is Relationships . We will explore how to stop jealousy spoiling our relationships, before considering how grief can affect us. We will consider how friendships will change as we get older, and think about how having a boyfriend or girlfriend might be different to having a friend.
Computing	This half term we will be using Purple Mash publishing software to work on Writing for Different Audiences . The children will take part in a simulation of a newspaper news-room, gathering information before they write their own article.
French	We will be working on Describing People . Children will learn how to describe their hair, eye colour, body type and clothing, and to describe other people and characters using <i>il</i> and <i>elle</i> .
