Year 6 Autumn Term 2 Curriculum Map 2023

Curriculum	Topics
Area English	Pupils will be reading and exploring the book 'Shackleton's Journey' by William Grill. Through the story, the
-Go	children will write their own setting descriptions, adventure story and newspaper report using our Jane Considine
	writing approach. In Grammar, this half term we will be focusing on using a range of punctuation including colons
	and semi colons and using direct and reported speech.
Maths	In Maths, we will be starting off the half term by looking at properties of numbers including exploring multiples,
i-ideli3	factors, prime numbers and square numbers. We will then move onto exploring fractions. Children will learn how
	to compare and order fractions, add and subtract fractions and find fractions of whole numbers. On Fridays,
	Children will continue to work on their arithmetic skills focussing on multiplying and dividing decimal numbers by
	10, 100 and 1000 and also decimal numbers.
Science	Our Science topic this half term is Evolution and Inheritance. During this unit, children will learn about the
Science	famous works of Mary Anning and how fossils are formed. They will explore Charles Darwin's theory of Evolution
	and how certain animals have become extinct over time. Children will move onto look at how humans have
112-4	evolved and how our characteristics can be inherited and acquired.
History	The Impact of World War Two Pupils will learn all about World War Two and the impacts this had on Britain
	and also in Germany. They will begin by exploring why Britain went to war and how the people of Britain
	responded during the war effort. They will explore the impacts of evacuation for children and the role of women
	during the war. They will find out about the Blitz the battle of Britain. They will also look at the local impact of
	the war in Carleton.
DT	<u>Making Waistcoats</u> Design Technology work this half term will focus on pupils developing their designing,
	creating and sewing skills to produce their own waistcoat. They will decorate and evaluate their waistcoats
	according to their success criteria.
Music	<u>Singing</u> This half term, we will be practising and performing songs for our young voices concert. Children will be
	learning different melodies and developing their understanding of pitch and rhythm. They will work in groups to
	create different parts and perform them to an audience.
P.E.	Year Six will have their weekly PE lessons on a Tuesday and Wednesday . On Tuesday afternoon Howard from
	Fire House dance studios is coming in to teach the children a dance routine. On Wednesday Skipton Tennis
	Centre are coming to school to develop their tennis skills and play matches.
R.E.	What does it mean for Muslims to follow God? Children will learn about Muslims in our local area. They will also

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	look at the 5 pillars of Islam and how Muslims use these to help them on their journey of life. Finally, children will
	look why Muslims go on a pilgrimage.
P.S.H.E	<u>Celebrating Difference</u> Through this unit of work pupils will work through a series of lessons in order to celebrate
	the importance of being unique and show respect for similarity and difference. They will learn more about
	discrimination, prejudice and racism.
Computing	Online safety and Spreadsheets Pupils begin the half term by exploring the importance of online safety and how
	they can keep themselves safe online. They will then move onto using spreadsheets and creating their own.
French	<u>Environment –</u> children will learn key vocabulary to describe where they live and the local area.

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
