Year 1 Summer Term 1 Curriculum Map 2024

| Curriculum Area | Topics |

| English | In our fiction unit we will be continuing focusing on the book – The way back home by Oliver Jeffers. We will be developing many sentence ideas focussing on the effective use of adjectives, verbs, punctuation, and sentence structure. We will then use the structure of this story to independently re write our own story. |
| Maths | In maths we will begin the term by focusing on length and height. In this unit of work the children will be comparing and measuring the length and height of objects. We will then move on to mass and volume, where the children will develop an understanding of mass, volume, and capacity and how to measure and compare them. |
| Science | In this unit, the children will develop their understanding of different plants and trees. The children will learn the different parts of flowering plants, including roots, stem, leaves and flowers and that trees have a trunk. The children will learn common types of plants and trees and will practice recognizing these by sight, including sunflower, dandelion, oak tree and birch tree. |
| Geography | In this unit, the children will gain a geographical insight into where some of their favourite animals live and their habitats, including pandas, penguins, sharks and elephants. The children will use their knowledge from previous units to identify which continents and countries these animals are from. The children will also develop their understanding of the issues facing landscapes, countries and continents that the animals live in. |
| Art | In this unit, the children will develop their understanding that art can be made in different ways. The children will choose, measure, arrange and fix different materials, as well as practice plaiting, threading and knotting techniques. The children will also develop wrapping and weaving techniques. |
| Music | In this unit, the children will use 'In the Groove' by Joanna Mangona to understand and explore different styles of music. The children will appraise the song and breakdown the key features of different styles of music. The children will then learn to improvise and compose their own pieces of music and rhythms using the glockenspiel instrument. |
| P.E | In PE we will be focusing on invasion games. In this unit, pupils develop their understanding of attacking and defending and what being 'in possession' means. They use and develop skills such as sending and receiving with both feet and hands, as well as dribbling with both feet and hands. They have the opportunity to play uneven and even sided games. They learn how to score points in these types of games and how to play to the rules. |
| R.E | In this unit, the children will look at two commandments made by Jesus; 'Love God' and 'Love your neighbour as you love yourself' and how Christians use these to help others in need. The children will also learn the story of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25 – 37) and how this story encourages Christians to act as a 'neighbour' when someone is in need. |
| P.S.H.E | In PSHE this half term pupils will explore and identify their own relationships with family and friends, and how to maintain good relationships with people who are important to us. |
| Computing | In this unit the children will develop their understanding of spreadsheets. The children will explore and experiment with spreadsheets by entering data, adding images as well as, moving and creating new cells. |
