Year 2 Spring Term 1 Curriculum Map 2024

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	Our writing this half term will be based on 'The Owl Who Was Afraid pf the Dark' by Jill Tomlinson. We will follow the Jane Considine writing scheme to write effective sentences, using imagination days and plot points to help us. For our independent write at the end of this unit, we will re-tell the story.
Maths	Shape: in this unit children will be able to identify 2D and 3D shapes. They will recognise faces, vertices and edges and find lines of symmetry. In the money unit, children will recognise coins and notes up to $£50$ and use money to add and subtract.
Science	In this unit of work pupils will learn about the uses of everyday materials including wood, plastic, metal, glass, brick, paper and cardboard. Pupils will compare the suitability of different everyday materials for different purposes. They will also explore how objects made of some everyday materials can change shape. Finally, pupils will learn about new discoveries which have been made over time with a specific focus on John McAdam.
Geography	Throughout this topic, pupils will link the everyday experience of buying and eating food within the UK with their growing geographical understanding if the world. Pupils will participate in fieldwork within the local area to show them the connections between the food we buy and how much of it comes from the UK. They will learn about what farming is and what a farmer does. They will also find out about some of the traditional foods that originate in the UK.
Art	In this unit of work, pupils will extend their knowledge of clay to help them make and produce clay models such as thumb pots and clay tiles. They will use impressing techniques to add detail to their clay and learn how to successfully join clay together using scoring techniques and slip (water and clay solution) to help them decorate and add features.
Music	Using Charanga, the children will learn to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song. Children will listen and appraise classic Rock songs. The song is 'I Wanna Play in a Band.'
P.E.	Dance: in this unit we will learn how to perform dances using simple movement patterns. Sending and receiving: in this unit children will master basic movements including throwing and catching. They will participate in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending.
R.E.	In this unit of work pupils will learn that each person is unique and important and that Christians and Jews believe that God values everyone. They will also find out about the 'Golden Rule' to illustrate a non-religious view of the value of all people. Pupils will then consider the stories Christians and Jews tell about the beginning of the world and will explore why it is important that everybody cares for the natural world.
P.S.H.E	In this unit of work pupils will talk about setting realistic goals and how they can achieve them. They will discuss perseverance when they find things difficult as well as recognising their strengths as a learner. The children will talk about group work and reflect on who they work well with and who they don't. They will also talk about sharing success with other people.
