Year 2 Spring Term 2 Curriculum Map 2024

Curriculum Area	Topics
ENGLISH	Our writing this half term will be based on a fable called 'The Crow's Tale' by Naomi Howarth. We will follow the Jane Considine writing scheme to write effective sentences, using imagination days and plot points to help us. For our independent write at the end of this unit, we will write a character description.
MATHS	We will continue our shape unit first then begin a unit in money. Children will recognise coins and notes up to £50 and use money to add and subtract.
SCIENCE	We will continue with our previous unit of work, learning about the uses of everyday materials. They will explore how objects made of some everyday materials can change shape through explorations and investigations.
HISTORY	In this unit pupils will be focusing on the life and achievements of Captain James Cook. They will begin by finding out about his early life, his passion to be at sea and his three main voyages. They will then investigate his first exploration in depth and how he discovered the east coast of Australia. Lastly, they will think about why Cook was so special and how he helped others.
DT	In this unit of work, pupils will design and create a functional Ferris wheel, learn how different components fit together so that the wheel rotates and the structure stands freely.
MUSIC	Using Charanga, the children will learn to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song. Children will listen and appraise classic Rock songs. The song is 'zoo time.'
P.E.	In this dance unit on a Tuesday, we will learn how to perform dances using simple movement patterns with the support of Firehouse dance! Every Wednesday, in yoga, pupils learn about mindfulness and body awareness. They begin to learn poses and techniques that will help them to connect their mind and body. The unit looks to improve well-being by building strength, flexibility, co-ordination and balance. The learning includes breathing and meditation through fun and engaging activities. Pupils work independently, with a partner and small group. This unit links to the following strands of the NC: master basic movements as well as developing balance, agility, and co-ordination.
R.E.	In this unit of work pupils will recognise that God, Incarnation, Gospel and Salvation are part of the 'big story' of the Bible. They will tell stories of Holy Week and Easter and make a link with the idea of Salvation (Jesus rescuing people). They will find out how Christians show their beliefs about Jesus as saviour in Church worship and will think, talk, and ask questions about the idea of forgiveness.
P.S.H.E	In this unit of work pupils will learn about healthy food and making healthy choices. They will talk about things that make them feel relaxed and stressed and will understand the difference between being healthy and unhealthy. They will find out that germs cause illness and that all household products, including medicines, can be harmful if not used properly.
