Year 2 Summer Term 1 Curriculum Map 2024

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	This term our focus book is the moving story 'The Builder Boy' by Ross Montgomery. The children will further develop their Year 2 writing skills. The unit will be completed with an independent write – a letter to Grandma.
Maths	This term we will be learning how to multiply and divide (2,5, and 10 times tables). We shall then learn about fractions, focusing on $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a quantity and shape.
Science	In this unit of work, pupils will complete practical experiments to find out how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. They will then find out the specific requirements plants need to grow and stay healthy.
Geography	Throughout this unit of work, pupils will learn about the ancient and modern wonders of the world. They will identify the different wonders studied and use atlases, maps and globes to locate some of the wonders. They will compare and contrast different places and will learn about physical and human features of the world wonders. Pupils will also express opinions about local wonderful places.
Art	In this unit of work, pupils will focus on developing their knowledge of weaving and painting. They will begin learning the craft of weaving in order to create a checkerboard. The children will then learn about the artist Clarice Cliff, taking inspiration from her works to develop their painting skills by exploring colour mixing and brush strokes.
Music	Using Charanga, the children will learn to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song. Children will listen and appraise classic Rock songs. The song is 'zoo time.'
P.E	This term we are very lucky and have the exciting Forest School working with us. Another letter has been sent home with details about this. The class will be divided into two groups and whilst one group develops their PSHE skills, the other half will embark on wall and ball skills. Both groups will enjoy both activities in the afternoon.
R.E	In this unit of work pupils will find out about Muslim ways of life, beliefs and festivals. This will then support pupils to develop thoughtful ideas and viewpoints of their own about some religious and spiritual questions
P.S.H.E	In this unit of work pupils will learn about healthy food and making healthy choices. They will talk about things that make them feel relaxed and stressed and will understand the difference between being healthy and unhealthy. They will find out that germs cause illness and that all household products, including medicines, can be harmful if not used properly.
Computing	In this unit the children will use Purple Mash tool 2paint a picture. They will learn about the works of the following artists: Piet Mondrian, William Morris, the Impressionists, Surrealists and the Pointillist technique.
