## Year 3 Spring Term 2 Curriculum Map 2024

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	<p>Our <b>Narrative</b> unit is based around the book 'The Secret of Black Rock' by Joe-Todd Stanto. We will be completing our sentence stacking and then our independent writing, we will be presenting our sentences and writing for display.</p> <p><b>Non Fiction: Diary writing</b> is the genre we will be focusing on. This unit sees the fundamentals of diary writing whilst also building on our previous sentence stacking lessons.</p>
Maths	<p>This term, we will be starting a new unit on <b>Length and Perimeter</b>. The focus of this unit is to learn how to measure different lengths of various objects. The children will also learn how to compare the lengths of different items, and how to measure items that are not entirely straight. The children will finish this unit by learning about perimeter and how to measure it accurately. After this unit, the children will come on to learning about <b>Fractions</b>. They will learn how to calculate fractions and compare them to one another.</p>
Science	<p><b>'Forces'</b> This unit will teach the children about the many forces affecting objects in everyday life. They will look at contact and non-contact forces, how different objects move on different surfaces, as well as the properties of magnetism.</p>
History	<p>In History this half term, the children will be completing a unit on <b>Our Local Area: Carleton Mill Victorian's Study</b>. The children will be investigating the history of Carleton Mill. They will date back its history to the Victorian era and learn how it has changed over time.</p>
D.T	<p>This half term, the children will be looking at <b>Mechanical Systems: Pneumatic Toys</b>. The children will be investigating the function and design of pneumatic toys and will use this knowledge to design their own.</p>
French	<p>The children will learn the names and features of animals as well as specific school-related vocabulary this half term.</p>
Music	<p>This term, the children will be completing a unit on <b>The Dragon Song</b>. The children will be looking at the specific factors that make up a song and will understand its creation through the use of these individual parts.</p>
P.E.	<p>The children will be continuing their work with <b>Firehouse Dance</b> this half term. They will continue to develop their understanding and fluidity with street style dances and experiment with the formation of routines.</p>
R.E.	<p>The children will be identifying <b>Why Christians celebrate Good Friday</b>. They will understand the Easter story of Jesus dying for the human race. The children will also understand why this day is celebrated and the significance this has on the Christian faith.</p>
P.S.H.E	<p><b>Healthy Me:</b> The children will develop their understanding of what it means to be 'healthy'. We will look at specific attributes of health including exercise, nutrition and happiness. They will also look at harmful things to avoid and how to stay safe on the internet.</p>
Computing	<p>This term we will be continuing our work with <b>Email and Email Safety</b>. The children will learn how to stay safe on the internet when interacting with emails. They will then move on to look at <b>Branching Databases</b>. They will look at the different ways that information is stored and how to transfer data from one database to another.</p>
