## Year 4 Spring Term 2 Curriculum Map 2023-2024

Curriculum Area	Material Covered
English	We will be focusing on writing a non-fiction script for a factual tour of the Water Cycle using the book <b>Once Upon a Raindrop</b> . We will use our prior knowledge and vocabulary to ensure an accurate piece of writing.
Maths	We will start by focusing on <b>Length &amp; Perimeter</b> this half term, including calculating the perimeter of different shapes, and working with metres and kilometres. We will then begin looking at <b>Fractions</b> , including equivalent fractions, and counting in fractions, before moving on to adding and subtracting fractions, and finding fractions of amounts.
Science	This half term, we'll be looking at <b>Sound</b> . We will begin by exploring how sound is made through vibrations, and learning how sound is heard by the human ear. We will explore how the properties of objects affect the sounds they produce, and explore the link between the volume of sounds and the size of the vibrations that produce them. Finally, we will investigate the relationship between distance from a sound source and the volume of the sound.
History	We will be studying <b>Roman Britain</b> this half term. We will learn about the Roman invasion of Britain and its impact on the Celts. We will explore the nature of Roman settlement in Britain and consider whether it was a positive experience for different groups. Finally, we will explore the long-term legacy of Roman occupation.
DT	This half term, we'll be exploring and creating <b>Cars</b> using a slingshot mechanism. Using careful joining techniques, we will construct a wooden chassis for the car, before constructing the body of the car and putting it to the test!
Music	We will be learning to sing the song <b>Lean on Me</b> . We will then play the glockenspiel part to the song, and learn to improvise and compose our own ideas.
P.E.	This half term we'll be developing our <b>throwing, catching and hitting</b> skills through lots of games and tasks, as well as continuing with <b>Skipton Tennis</b> on Wednesdays.
R.E.	This half term we'll be considering the question <b>After Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost</b> , focusing on the concepts of the Holy Spirit and the Kingdom of God.
P.S.H.E	Our topic this half term is <b>Healthy Me</b> . We will be looking at healthy friendships and how to manage our friendship difficulties, and we will investigate the risks involved with smoking and drinking alcohol.
Computing	This half term we will be using <b>Logo</b> , a text-based coding program, to control an on-screen marker to draw mathematical patterns.
French	We will be exploring the unit <b>My Town</b> , learning vocabulary and phrases to describe the place we live in.
