## Year 5 Spring Term 2 Curriculum Map 2023-2024

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	In their narrative work, the children will focus on the short film ' <u>The Fantastic Flying Books of Mr Morris Lessmore</u> ' by <u>Moonbot Studios</u> . They will use this story to craft and construct different sentences which will develop their understanding of grammar, spelling and punctuation knowledge. The children will then complete an independent write, enabling them to apply what they have learned from this unit.
Maths	We will start the term by looking at <u>fractions</u> . In this unit, the children will learn to multiply non-unit fractions, unit fractions and mixed numbers by an integer. They will then move onto <u>decimals and percentages</u> . In this unit, the children will look at the links between decimals and equivalent fractions and they will learn to convert decimals and fractions to percentages.
Science	<u>Forces</u> – In this unit, the children will learn about different forces and the impact these forces have on objects, including; gravity, air resistance, water resistance and friction. They will complete different experiments involving these forces to see their effect. The children will also learn and recognise that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.
History	<u>Vikings</u> – In this unit, the children will build on their previous knowledge of Anglo-Saxon Britain and will learn about the Viking invasion of Britain in 793AD. They will use a range of sources to learn how and why the Vikings came to Britain and their reasons for settling in Britain. The children will also investigate the impact this had on the Anglo-Saxons already in Britain and how the Anglo-Saxon and Viking era ended, due to the Norman Conquest in 1066.
DT	<u>Pop-Up Book</u> – In this unit, the children will design and produce a children's pop-up book. The book they design will be aimed at Year One children and they will learn about the different mechanisms and structures involved in creating a pop-up book and how to use layers and spacers to hide parts of their mechanisms in the book.
Music	<u>Make you feel my love</u> – In this unit, the learning is focused around the song 'Make You Feel My Love' by Adele. The children will take part in a variety of games and activities, which will help them to learn about the different dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc.) within the song. They will learn to sing the song and then use recorders to play the song instrumentally.
P.E.	<u>Swimming</u> – Every <u>Tuesday</u> afternoon, the children will have swimming lessons. The children will learn and develop a range of swimming strokes, including breaststroke and front crawl, and will learn how to stay safe in the water.
R.E.	<u>What does it mean for a Jewish person to follow God?</u> – In this unit, the children will learn to identify and explain Jewish beliefs about God. They will be able to give examples of some texts that say what God is like and be able to explain how Jewish people interpret them. The children will then consider and weigh up the value of Jewish worship, traditions and beliefs in the lives of Jews today.
P.S.H.E.	<u>Healthy Me</u> – In this unit, the children will look at the health risks associated with smoking, vaping and misusing alcohol. The children will look at both physical and mental risks and what these risks look like. The children will learn basic emergency procedures and practice these, such as the recovery position, and they will learn how to get help if they found themselves in an emergency situation. The children will also learn about the influence the media, social media and celebrity culture has on certain body types and certain foods and diets.
Computing	<u>Databases</u> – In this unit, the children will learn how to search for information within a database and will learn how to contribute to a whole-class database. They will then create their own database around a chosen topic.
French	<u>Hobbies</u> – In this unit, the children will learn vocabulary that focuses on hobbies. They will learn how to name hobbies, including music and films. They will learn how to talk about types of music and musical instruments and how to give a variety of opinions. They will also learn how to talk about different types of films.
