Year 6 Spring Term 2 Curriculum Map 2024

Curriculum	Topics
Area	
English	<u>Paperman</u> Pupils will be using the short Disney film 'Paperman' to inspire their narrative writing. Pupils will begin by investigating the different plot points in the film. Through their sentence stacking lessons, they will form sentences which include grammatical features such as time adverbials, semi-colons and alliteration. Pupils will use the structure from shared writing to plan and write their own story based on the film.
Maths	<u>Fractions, decimals and percentages</u> Within our Maths topics this half term, pupils work on skills such as multiplying and dividing decimals, finding equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages and calculating percentages of an amount.
Science	<u>Light</u> In this unit of work pupils will begin by identifying a range of light sources and exploring how light travels. They will then study how the eye works and will find out that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye. Finally pupils will plan and carry out an investigation to explore how shadows change through the day.
History	What makes people go on a journey? The children will explore the question of why people go on a journey, and look at five very different types of journey in depth. The journeys selected span from the Tudor period to those undertaken today. The children begin by studying the voyages of Walter Raleigh, then the voyage of the Irish 3rd class passengers on the Titanic, before learning about the Kindertransport in World War Two and the voyage of the Empire Windrush.
DT	<u>Structures</u> Pupils will consider the different structures found in playgrounds, often referred to collectively as playground apparatus. They will discuss the design criteria that a playground needs to meet and will be challenged to redesign the village playground. Using their sketchbooks, pupils will plan their own model playgrounds before using a range of tools and materials to construct their designs.
Music	<u>Happy</u> All learning in this unit of work will focus around the song 'Happy' by Pharrell Williams. The children will learn that 'Happy' is a pop song that has a soul music sound and groove from the 1960s; very much like a Motown song. Pupils will compare other songs in different styles about being happy and will work together to sing the song and perform compositions within the song.
P.E	<u>Tag Rugby and Badminton</u> Pupils will have P.E lessons on a <u>Monday</u> and <u>Friday</u> . In Tag Rugby lessons, pupils will develop their understanding of the attacking and defending principles when participating in invasion games. Within their Badminton unit of work, pupils will learn how to use their badminton skills, strategies and tactics to outwit the opposition.
R.E	What difference does the resurrection make to Christians? Pupils will learn that Christians read the 'big story' of the Bible as pointing out the need for God to save people. They will participate in drama and discussion activities to help them to understand how the Gospels give accounts of Jesus' death and resurrection. Pupils will then consider how believing in Jesus' resurrection might make a difference to how Christians live today.
P.S.H.E	Healthy me The children will learn more about living a healthy life style. They will learn about legal and illegal drugs and the effects of these. They will learn about gang exploitation and how peer pressure can influence our choices.
Computing	Blogging Pupils will learn how a blog can be used as an information text and will explore the features of successful blog writing. Pupils will then work collaboratively to plan, create and present their own blog.
French	<u>In France</u> During this unit, pupils will be introduced to some French foods, the location of some French cities and some popular tourist attractions in Paris. They will also learn how to say the points of the compass and how to discuss which countries speak French.

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
