Year 1 Autumn Term 2 Curriculum Map 2021

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	Pinnocchio Pupils will be reading and exploring the narrative text ‘Pinnocchio.’ Through the story, they will investigate the structure and the key grammatical features of a recount such as adjectives, time adverbials and dialogue. Pupils will then use structure from shared writing to write their own recount.
Maths	In Maths we will be looking at addition and subtraction within 10 and Geometry: Shape . Within these topics, pupils will develop a concrete understanding and recall of their number bonds to ten. They will also develop mental strategies for adding on and counting back. Pupils will continue to work on their personal key instant recall facts which will help to improve their mental calculations. It is important that they learn and practise this target at home each week as part of their Maths homework.
Science	Seasonal Change In this unit of work pupils will observe changes to the world around them in the four different seasons- focus on Autumn and Winter. They will explore how the weather changes and why the day seems to vary in length.
History	My Family History In this unit, the children will explore similarities and differences between their own lives and those of people their grandparents’ age. The unit focuses on different topics, including homes, toys, shops and schools.
DT	Mechanisms- Sliders and levers Design Technology work this half term will focus on pupils learning about how mechanisms work. Pupils will create pieces of work that can be moved using levers and sliders.
Music	How does Music tell stories about the past? This unit of work pupils will be celebrating a wide range of musical styles while singing, playing, composing and performing songs that tell stories from the past.
P.E.	Gymnastic skills Pupils will be working hard on developing their Balance, coordination, strength, flexibility and agility skills. Children will develop and link simple balance and movement skills to create a short routine. PE days for Year 1 are Mondays and Thursdays
R.E.	Why does Christmas matter to Christians? Pupils will be able to give a clear, simple account of the story of Jesus’ birth and why Jesus is important for Christians. Children will also give examples of ways in which Christians use the story of the nativity to guide their beliefs and actions at Christmas and identify what they are thankful for at Christmas.
P.S.H.E	Celebrating Difference Through this unit of work pupils will develop an understanding and accept that everyone is different, Include others when working and playing, Know how to help if someone is being bullied, Try to solve problems and the importance of using kind words. They will also identify how their are different from their peers and celebrate how diverse people are.
Computing	Pictograms Pupils begin the half term by exploring how to make digital pictograms to represent and record data. They will learn to use the program 2Count to create their own pictograms.
