Below is an outline of the work to be covered in Class Five over the next half term (Autumn 2 2021 **Year5.**)

Subject	Topics
Literacy	The children will base their 'Non-fiction work' on a balanced argument text model around 'screen use'. Using the Jane Considine, 'Write stuff' approach, the children will develop their writing skills through studying the features of this particular genre and sentence stacking. They will go on to independently write their own non-fiction piece of writing.
Numeracy	This half term children will revisit how to use bar charts, pictograms and tables to interpret and present discrete data. They will also build on their times table knowledge and find multiples of whole numbers and study the relationship between multiplication and division and use arrays to show the relationship between them. After this they will go onto study prime numbers.
Science	This half term the children will learn about 'Light' Unit of work, how we see, shadows, reflection and refraction. The children will learn how light travels and how this enables us to see objects.
History	In this unit, the children will study life after Roman Britain; and to understand the various groups who invaded Britain. A comparison will be made between the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings.
DT	In this unit, the children will explore framed structures. They will develop their understanding of secure structures and introduces them to measuring, sawing and joining wood accurately. After learning about different types of bridges and also exploring how the strength of structures can be affected by the shapes used. Children create their own wooden bridge and test its durability.
ICT	In this unit, the children will gain a greater understanding of the impact that sharing digital content can have. They will consider sources of support when using technology and review children' responsibility to one another in their online behaviour.
P.E.	This half term the children will develop their skills in Tag rugby and skills in balance, co-ordination, strength, flexibility, agility. Also within learning about a Healthy Lifestyle - Fats and Water.
R.E.	Was Jesus the Messiah? In this unit the children will learn how to place Incarnation and Messiah within the 'big story' of the Bible. Identify Gospel and prophecy texts, using technical terms. Explain connections between biblical texts, Incarnation and Messiah, using theological terms. Show how Christians put their beliefs about Jesus' Incarnation into practice in different ways in celebrating Christmas.
P.S.H.C. E	In this unit the children will study - Celebrating Differences. Children will study their own culture and the awareness of attitude towards people from different races. They will look at a range of strategies for managing their feelings in bullying situations and problem solving to deal with these issues.
French	In this Unit- On fait la fete-the children -In this unit children learn language relating to celebrations of special occasions and of their achievements in activities and games. They also learn to say the name of the month in which they celebrate their birthday.
Music	Pupils will study an integrated approach to music; where games and the interrelated dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm and pitch, singing and instruments are linked together. All the learning is focused around – Young voices.
