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Below is an outline of the work to be covered over the next half term (Spring Term Two 2021) in **Class One**

Subject	Topics
Phonics	<i>Reception Pupils</i> will continue to recap Phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs in phonics lessons to help consolidate recognition and application. We will continue to focus on sight reading high frequency and tricky words to improve fluency and comprehension in reading. <i>Year 1</i> pupils will continue to learn alternative digraphs/split digraphs and work on Phase 5 phonics. We will focus on sight reading and spelling Year 1 Common Exception Words . <i>Please continue to support your child with their homework (practice the correct letter formation, recognise phonics sounds, revisit tricky word flashcards, and listen to them read as regularly as possible) in order to encourage secure foundations for reading and writing. 'Practice makes perfect!'</i>
Literacy	This half term in Literacy, pupils in Class One will focus on writing a recount . Pupils will listen to and join in with a recount of Goldilocks and the Three Bears . We will create a story map and retell the story using actions. Pupils will use hot seating and role play to pretend to be a character from the story and will also write a recount in the role of Baby Bear.
Mathematics	In Maths, Reception children will carry out a unit on length and height, time, and place value within 10. <i>Year 1</i> pupils will focus on recognizing, sorting and making patterns with 3D shapes . We will also carry out a unit on place value within 20. <i>Please continue to work on your KIRF Maths targets at home.</i>
Music	Our Music focus this half term will be Pitch and tempo . Pupils will learn how to identify high and low notes and to compose a simple tune. They will continue to learn to sing nursery rhymes and action songs.
P.E.	During this half term, pupils will carry out a unit on Yoga . These yoga and mindfulness sessions have physical, mental and emotional benefits for children. We are encouraging them to move and stretch their bodies - and squeezing in breathing, relaxation and visualisation techniques along the way.
R.E.	In this unit pupils will carry out a unit on Salvation and ask the question How can we help others when they need it? We will learn about lent and think about ways of helping others. Pupils will learn the Bible story The Good Samaritan and make their own prayers.
PSHE	Class One will be carrying out a unit on Me and My Future . This will focus on recognising coins and bank notes that we use on a daily basis in the UK. Children will learn that they have to pay for what they buy and explore paying using different coins.
Computing Skills	Class one will develop skills in Word Processing . They will learn to type words with improving pace and confidence. Pupils will use the space bar to make space and delete to delete letters/words. We will learn how to make a new line using enter/return.
Science	During Science lesson, Class One will carry out a unit called Socks . Pupils will develop their understanding of materials, forces and simple ideas about keeping warm (insulation). We will compare materials and have fun using our senses to make feely and smelly socks.
Topic	Our topic for this half term is Habitats . Pupils will learn about what a habitat is and understand what makes a good habitat. We will match animals to appropriate habitats.
