Below is an outline of the work to be covered over the next half term (Autumn Two 2020) in **Class 3 Year 2/3**.

Subject	Topics
Literacy	Recount Texts: Diaries Pupils will be reading and comparing the diaries of Samuel Pepys and John Evelyn. They will explore what their diaries say about the events of The Great Fire of London. They will explore the key features of recount texts such as the past tense and conjunctions. They will then plan and write a realistic recount text from a diary written in the Great Fire of London. Spellings: Pupils in Years Two and Three will continue to receive a list of spellings each week, which they will be expected to learn and practice at home. Please note pupils will be tested on these spellings in the classroom every Friday .
Numeracy	In Numeracy we will be looking at the areas of Addition and Subtraction, Money and Multiplication and Division . Within these topics, Year Two pupils work on skills such as using the £ and p sign, using notes and coins to make particular amounts and recalling and using the multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Year Three pupils will work on adding and subtracting strategies, recalling and using the multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables and solving multiplication and division problems. All pupils will continue to work on their personal key instant recall facts which will improve their mental calculations and support the Numeracy work they are focusing on in school. It is important that pupils learn and practise this target at home each week as part of their Numeracy homework. Pupils will be tested on their target every Tuesday in class.
Science	Light Pupils will learn that we see with our eyes and that light helps us to see. Through practical investigations, they will find out about the variety of light sources all around us and how these light sources can vary in brightness and in colour. Pupils will then focus on the sun. They will find out how the sun gives us daylight and also how the sun can be dangerous.
History	Fire! Fire! In this unit, the children will explore two very different events within the Stuart period. First, the children will investigate the events of the Gunpowder Plot which led to Bonfire Night being introduced into the UK calendar, with opportunities provided for pupils to recount their Bonfire Night experiences. Next, they will study the Great Fire of London, and decide whether or not it improved London for those living there. They will learn to interpret evidence from the time and afterwards, examining whether the sources are reliable.
Art and DT	Collage and Construction Art and DT work this half term will be linked to the class history topic. Pupils will be constructing houses in the style of those that were found in London in 1666. They will use collage to create a Great Fire of London scene.
Music	Orchestral Instruments Pupils will work on experimenting with, creating, selecting and combining sounds using the interrelated dimensions of music
P.E.	Dance Pupils will develop their dance skills by performing a range of body action with control and quality and will work on identifying what makes a performance effective.
R.E.	Christmas: Light In this unit of work pupils will explore the use of light as a symbol within Christianity. They will consider what it means for Jesus to be seen as the 'Light of the World'. Pupils will also look at light in the Christmas story and will think about how lights are used in other Christian celebrations.
P.S.H.C. E.	Keeping myself safe Pupils will consider how to keep themselves safe at home, school and in other familiar situations. They will investigate how to ask for help if they need it and how different people in their community can help to keep them safe.
Computing	Spreadsheets Pupils will be able to explain what the rows and columns are in spreadsheet. They will create a table of data on a spreadsheet and will also use a spreadsheet to solve a mathematical puzzle.
French	Core Unit Two In this unit, pupils will learn that days of the week and the name of most colours in the French language, They will be able to recall numbers up to 20 in the French language and will be able to respond to a question about likes and dislikes.
