



Carleton Endowed CE (VA) Primary School

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Below is an outline of the work to be covered over the next half term (Spring Two 2021) in **Class 3 Year 2/3**.

Subject	Topics
Literacy	<p>Reports Pupils will read and compare different reports and learn about the key features of a report. Through this unit of work, pupils will continue to work on using conjunctions to construct compound and complex sentences in order to vary their writing. Pupils will also be learning to use and apply paragraphs in their work. They will then plan and write their own reports.</p> <p>Spellings: Pupils in Years Two and Three will continue to receive a list of spellings each week, which they will be expected to learn and practice at home. Please note pupils will be tested on these spellings in the classroom every Friday.</p>
Numeracy	In Numeracy we will be looking at the areas of Fractions and Length and Height . Within these topics, Year Two pupils work on skills such as making equal parts and recognising a half and a quarter. Year Three pupils will work on recognising and using fractions as numbers, comparing fractions and adding and subtracting lengths. All pupils will continue to work on their personal key instant recall facts which will improve their mental calculations and support the Numeracy work they are focusing on in school. It is important that pupils learn and practise this target at home each week as part of their Numeracy homework. Pupils will be tested on their target every Tuesday .
Science	Our Local Environment In this unit of work pupils will learn about the differences between things that are living and things that are not and the variety of ways living things can be grouped. They will understand how most living things live in habitats to which they are suited but how environmental changes can threaten these habitats.
History	Who is our local hero? In this unit, pupils will investigate the life and achievements of the local explorer William Cecil Slingsby. They will begin by finding out what a hero is and what qualities they might have. They will then learn about the different expeditions William Cecil Slingsby went on and will use different historical sources to find out about his life.
Art and DT	Art and DT work this half term will be linked to the class history topic. Pupils will design and make a mask for their own superhero, draw a portrait of William Cecil Slingsby and will construct a suitable mode of transport for an explorer to use.
Music	Dynamics, Timbre, Tempo and Motifs In this unit of work pupils will work on comparing two pieces of music by the same composer, identifying changes in dynamics and use appropriate musical vocabulary and recognising and naming different instruments.
P.E.	<p>Net and Wall Games Pupils in the hub will be working with Skipton Tennis Centre to focus on skills such as applying simple rules to games, demonstrating accuracy in sending a ball and playing co-operatively with others.</p> <p>Developing our Fitness Pupils working remotely will work on developing their fitness by completing different online PE sessions.</p>
R.E.	Sorrow and joy In this unit of work pupils will learn about what is celebrated during Holy Week and Easter. Through art, drama and musical activities pupils will connect up their own ideas and experiences to key elements of the stories of Holy Week and Easter.
P.S.H.C. E.	Me and my future Pupils will be focusing on a unit of work entitled 'Me and My Future'. They will begin by considering where money comes from and why we need to make choices when spending money. Through practical activities and shared reading, pupils will learn about saving money and how to keep it safe.
Computing	Making Music Pupils will be introduced to making music digitally using a programme called 2Sequence. They will explore, edit and combine sounds using 2Sequence and will think about how music can be used to express feelings.
French	Animals In this unit of work, pupils will learn how to say the names of animal homes in French. They will also become familiar with some useful prepositions and learn how to ask where something or someone is.
