Below is an outline of the work to be covered over the next half term (Autumn Two 2020) in **Class 4 Year 3/4.**

Subject	Topics
Literacy	<b>Adventure stories – Stig of the Dump</b> We will be reading the story in class and developing ideas about the structure of adventure stories. We will explore characters, settings and historical themes to help us write our own adventure story in the style of a historical adventure tale.
Numeracy	<b>Autumn Block 3 – Multiplication and division</b> Children will be working on their knowledge of multiplication and division facts and learning written methods to solve more complicated questions. Pupils will use this knowledge and critical thinking to help them solve numerical problems. Children will also be completing work on word problems linked to the four operations.
Science	<b>Food and our bodies</b> Children work scientifically on a variety of quick challenges and longer tasks to learn about food and their bodies. This topic looks at where animals get food from and why it is important, and skeletons, muscles and joints.
Expedition (Geog, History, Art and DT)	<b>The Stone age.</b> In this unit, the children will explore how life changed for people during different periods of the Stone Age, including the Early, Middle and New Stone Ages. They will cover why the period was called the Stone Age, and what archaeological evidence there is from the period.
ICT	<b>Spreadsheets.</b> Children will have the opportunity to explore spreadsheets and put computational thinking into practice. They will learn skills to input data and formula to work out calculations for them.
P.E.	<b>• Invasion Games-</b> We will be working with Skipton Tennis Centre to provide specialist invasion games sessions this term. We will learn the skills and techniques to play a selection of invasion games and develop an understanding of tactics, building up to playing competitive games.
R.E.	<b>Incarnation- Christmas- Mary's milestones</b> This half term, pupils will describe and explain key moments in Mary's life around the time of Jesus' birth and empathise with feelings of others. They will then reflect upon their own life journey so far and think about their future life.
P.S.H.C.E.	<b>Healthy living.</b> Pupils will learn about how to keep themselves healthy, they will also have the opportunity to plan and cook their own lunch following a recipe one morning during the half term.
French	<b>Playtime-</b> This half term, pupils will recognise a familiar word in a spoken sentence, given a visual prompt. Repeat and copy down a few short sentences about themselves. Play a simple French playground game, when given visual or spoken prompts. Repeat part of a simple French song. Spell basic French words with some help. Express an opinion with a simple phrase, given some assistance. We are also hoping to learn a Christmas song in French.
Music	<b>Wider Opportunities-</b> Guitar lessons This term we will be visited by a member of the North Yorkshire peripatetic team who will teach us basic music reading skills and techniques to play a guitar.
