

Carleton Endowed CE (VA) Primary School

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Below is an outline of the work to be covered over the next half term (Autumn 1 2020) in **Class 4.**

Subject	Topics
Literacy	Riddles Pupils will learn and share riddles. We will build up to writing who am I riddles to share interesting facts about ourselves with our new class. Persuasive writing (Holiday brochures) Linking literacy to our expedition topic we will look at travel brochures and tourist information leaflets for places around the UK. We will look at the language chosen to persuade people to visit before creating our own guides to places we love in the UK.
Numeracy	Autumn Block 1- Place Value Children will be working on their knowledge of place value to four places and deepening their understanding of the number system. Pupils will use this knowledge and critical thinking to help them solve numerical problems. Children will also be completing work on estimation.
Science	Rocks In this topic children work scientifically on a variety of quick investigations and longer tasks to learn about rocks. This topic covers the properties and uses of rocks, the rock family, soils and finally fossils.
Expedition (Geography, History, Art and DT)	Where in the world are we? In this unit, children will begin to understand the Earth better as a sphere, learning to rotate it mentally in 3-D. They will explore its representation in 2-D maps, and learn about the imaginary lines used (Equator, latitude, longitude, tropics and the International Date Line) to pinpoint global locations
ICT	Coding Children will have the opportunity to explore program design and put computational thinking into practice. They will use their coding to create programs with characters that complete actions set by the coder as well as solving bugs and glitches as they occur.
P.E.	Invasion Games- We will be working with Skipton Tennis Centre to provide specialist invasion games sessions this term. We will learn the skills and techniques to play a selection of invasion games and develop an understanding of tactics, building up to playing competitive games.
R.E.	Creation This half term, pupils will describe how and why Christians might pray to God, say sorry, forgive and ask for forgiveness. Make links between what stories in the Bible say about human beings, and pupils' own ideas about how people should behave
P.S.H.C.E.	We'll meet again- Sessions developed by Place2Be to support children returning to the school community focusing on their wellbeing following the Covid-19 pandemic Be Yourself Pupils will identify their strengths and achievements. They will begin to develop strategies to help them cope with uncomfortable feelings and identify that their feelings on the inside can be communicated to others in their body language as well as words. Begin to understand that mistakes are natural and how to move forward and learn from any mistake.
French	Home- pupils will learn the vocabulary they need in order to say where they live. By the end of the unit, they'll have learned all of the vocabulary they need to give details about a variety of rooms and furniture. They will be introduced to basic verbs associated with the daily routine, in the first person. Pupils will be able to do activities to recap colours and numbers as well as learning new vocabulary in this unit.
Music	Wider Opportunities- Guitar lessons This term we will be visited by a member of the North Yorkshire peripatetic team who will teach us basic music reading skills and techniques to play a guitar.
