Homework Policy



At Carleton Endowed School the aims of setting homework are to:

Responsibilities:

- * differentiate homework so that all children can build on previous learning
- * encourage pupils to undertake personal research which can extend knowledge and
- skills
- * keep in regular contact with parents and carers

Parents and carers are encouraged to:

- * supporting the school to maintain the homework Timetable
- * monitoring and supporting their child(ren) in the completion of the homework
- * maintaining resources 'on loan' from the school which are needed for the completion of the homework
- * keeping in regular contact with the school
