Orlaith said 'I felt nervous before the race, My heart was beating faster before I set off than during the race but I enjoyed it once I got going' An amazing achievement – well done!



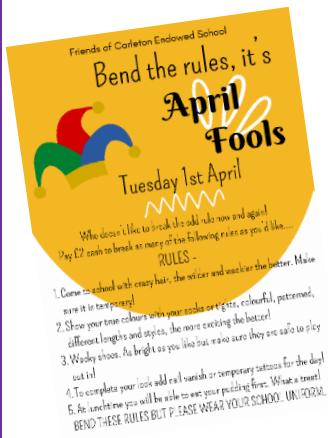
Friends of Carleton Endowed School Bend the rules, its April Fools!

The National College produces a weekly parent publication relating to children's online behaviour which we are able to share with you each week.

This week's publication is about **livestreaming** which is now a major part of children's entertainment, evolving from gamers sharing screens into a booming industry with diverse personalities. While watching streamers can be entertaining, it comes with no small number of risks for children, such as misinformation, negative influences, and inappropriate content. With over 2.5 million viewers on Twitch – the current most popular streaming platform – at any one time, this guide highlights the potential dangers associated with watching livestreams and the importance of staying informed.
