Dear parents and carers

As many of you are aware two **North Yorkshire Police** officers have been outside school at pick up and drop off times in the last few weeks. They came in response to messages from members of the community and more recently by parents worried about the safety of the children at the start and the end of the day.

What they saw was worrying. They saw various instances of vehicles being parked dangerously meaning children are forced to cross where it is unsafe to do so. This has been captured on officers' bodycam and in photographs. Please be aware that they will be issuing letters to the owners of these vehicles.

The Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents claims that **1,200 children are injured in traffic related collisions that happen within 500m of a school each month!** We need to avoid adding to this statistic

For the safety of all our children please follow the advice of the police below:

Set off sooner if you can

Park further away from the school and walk with your children to the school gates;

Wear appropriate bright clothing to make you and your child visible to motorists;

Drive slowly - Be aware of children attempting to cross the road between parked cars.

Pedestrians - do not attempt to cross the road between parked cars unless there is no other option, and only if you must.

KS1 Sports festival

This week has been anti-bullying week and the children have been considering the Anti-Bullying Alliance's chosen theme of Respect. As part of this, the KS2 classes had their third and final **Diversity Role Models** session on Monday.

As in previous sessions, everyone thoroughly enjoyed using Lego to explore the concepts covered. Year 3 and 4 pupils explored the history of the rainbow flag, while Year 5 and 6 pupils looked at the history of LGBTQ+ laws. The children have really enjoyed these sessions which have been really engaging, informative and thought provoking, helping children to value everyone regardless of similarities and differences.



Parent/Carer Celebration Collective Worship

This is our celebration assembly where we give out certificates and celebrate the achievements of the pupils. Lots of parents, carers and family members join us every week and the children really love to see them there.
