## Diversity role model workshop

Last Friday the children in reception and key stage 1 took part in a Diversity Role Model workshop provided by the DfE. They learnt to recognise and appreciate that all people are different and were

encouraged to celebrate this. They considered what makes them and other children special and unique and were encouraged to deepen their acceptance of difference through hearing a role model's story. Finally children learnt to celebrate differences and be inclusive of difference.
