## Safety at Water margins

North Yorkshire safeguarding children's partnership have asked headteachers to draw attention to their water safety information below:

One popular pastime for families is visiting open water, whether it's a lake, reservoir, or the sea. However, many children, young people, and even parents and carers are not aware of the dangers open water can pose. These dangers include diving into shallow water, unpredictable undercurrents, water temperature, and deep water, all of which can lead to potentially fatal accidents that are often preventable.

### British Summertime!

We love to be able to spend more time outside in the summer, so ask that children come to school prepared for everything the weather throws at us! Please could children arrive in school with sun protection already applied and a named sun hat to wear at break times. All day sun protection is the most convenient, but if your child needs to reapply their sun cream at lunch time, we ask that the bottle is

clearly labelled with their name and handed directly to the class teacher. We are unable to let other children share due to allergies.

**Please make sure your child's jumper is clearly named** – we are spending a lot of time trying to return jumpers to their owners after break times and our lost property box is overflowing!



For rainy days please make sure your child has a waterproof coat so that they can still go outside to play.

### Summer Reading Challenge



On Monday we will have a visit from the North Yorkshire library service who will be introducing this year's Summer Reading Challenge 'Marvellous Makers' which is themed around creativity.

The Summer Reading Challenge is aimed at children aged 4-11, encouraging them to keep reading and enjoying books throughout the summer. Children can sign up at any North Yorkshire library from 13<sup>th</sup> July and will receive their collector's folder to get them started.

There are stickers to collect along the way and children complete the challenge by reading at least 6 books by 7<sup>th</sup> September. All children who complete Marvellous Makers will be awarded a medal and a certificate. It's FREE to join your local library and FREE to sign up for Marvellous Makers.

Please can I remind all parents that the school day starts at 8:45am. Children are not supervised by school staff before this point and it is parents responsibility to keep them safe until the bell rings.
