Year Reception Summer Term Two Curriculum Map 2022

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	<u>Pigs Might Fly by Jonathan Emmett</u> Pupils will explore the story through different lenses and plot points. They will continue to investigate and develop a wide range of vocabulary and construct sentences which include feelings, actions, sounds and noticing. Pupils will then use story language to retell the story independently.
Maths	In Maths pupils will carry out a unit called <u>Finding My Pattern</u> . They will explore doubling, halving and sharing into groups. Pupils will also learn about odd and even numbers. They will then carry out a unit called <u>On The Move</u> where they will carry out various problem solving activities. Please continue to work on their personal <u>key instant recall facts</u> (KIRFS) and develop skills on <u>NumBots</u> which will help to improve their mental calculations. It is important that they learn and practise this target at home each week as part of their Maths homework. Pupils will continue to be tested on their target every other Wednesday / Thursday in class.
Science	<u>Seasons</u> In this unit of work pupils will learn all about the season Summer. They will learn to record the weather and identify typical weather for Summer. Pupils will identify clothes worn during Summer.
History	<u>Old and New Transport</u> Pupils learn to identify forms of transport used in the past and different forms of transport used today. They will place transport in order from oldest to newest.
Design Technology	<u>Junk Modelling</u> Pupils will learn about different techniques for joining materials, such as how to use adhesive tape and glue. They will create a junk model of a mode of transport and use tools and paint to construct and finalise their model.
Music	<u>Big Bear Funk</u> Pupils will learn to sing along with nursery rhymes and action songs. They will listen and respond to different styles of music, exploring a wide range of songs. Pupils will learn to find a funky pulse and copy-clap 3 or 4 word phrases from the song. They will keep the beat of the song with a pitched note and add pitched notes to the rhythm of the words in a song. Pupils will play patterns using a combination of any of the three notes, C,D and E.
P.E.	<u>Fundamental movement Skills</u> In this unit of work pupils will develop fundamental movement skills. They will develop skills in jumping, throwing, running.
R.E.	Pupils will explore the question <u>What is special about our world?</u> They will learn that the world is special and that some people believe that God created the world. Pupils will think about the wonders of the natural world and express their ideas and feelings.
P.S.H.E	<u>Changing Me</u> Pupils will learn to identify different parts of the body. They will identify some of the things I can do to stay healthy. Pupils will know that we all grow from babies to adults and that we go through lots of changes. They will also discuss and share how they feel about moving into Year 1.
Computing	<u>Early programming</u> In this unit of work pupils will learn how to programme in commands to make a Beebot move and carry out a range of instructions. They will learn to develop their directional language when programming in commands.
