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SIAMS Recommendations

We were really delighted with our SIAMS Report from the inspection in May 2017. We have tackled the following recommendations from SIAMS over the last few years to further improve our school;

- 1. Clarify children's understanding of different faiths and different expressions of Christianity so that they can more competently discern similarities and differences (SIAMS May 2017)**

Pupils are now able to articulate their understanding of different faiths and expressions of Christianity.

Units now placed into LTP throughout school.

Understanding Christianity training has taken place and units now successfully being used throughout the whole school.

We work in partnership with Bradford Interfaith Centre to learn about lots of their religions and the similarities and differences within these.

- 2. In R.E, identify next steps in their learning so that children are clear what they need to do to improve further (SIAMS May 2017)**

Children know their next steps and targets to achieve.

R.E assessments show that children are successfully moving their learning on and this is now tracked throughout school in our Life Without Levels tracker.

SIAMS audit has taken place and this has now helped to support our staff in our next steps for learning.

Collective Worship observations and pupil feedback show that pupils are planning and leading collective worship across school and this is helping to support R.E learning alongside collective worship.

Governor visits have all been extremely positive when looking at R.E and collective worship.

We have completed, reviewed and developed the new SIAMS evaluation schedule and SIAMS SEF which was launched in September 2018 (with a particular focus on Strand 7 and making links explicit in each strand by adding an additional box of evidence)

Every Monday there is now whole school collective worship in St Mary's Church. During lockdown, this has been via Microsoft Teams. These acts of collective worship have helped to support and promote R.E further throughout school.

We are hoping that during our next SIAMS inspection we can show our inspectors all of the wonderful things that our staff have invested their time in at our school.
