### Year 3 Spring Term 2 Curriculum Map 2022

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	<p><b><u>Narrative: The Incredible Book Eating Boy by Oliver Jeffers:</u></b> We will be using this humorous story as our stimulus to build our own sentences around each plot point to tell the story of Henry and his love of books. For our independent writing we will replicate a new plot and write a story about another 'incredible' person.</p> <p><b><u>Non Fiction: Letter Writing:</u></b> we will present a point of view in the form of a letter linking points persuasively and selecting style and vocabulary appropriately to the reader.</p>
Maths	<p><b><u>Length &amp; Perimeter:</u></b> In this unit the children are introduced to millimetres for the first time and build on their understanding of centimetres and metres. We use different measuring equipment including rulers, tape measures, metre sticks and trundle wheels. They discuss which equipment is the most appropriate depending on the object they are measuring.</p> <p><b><u>Fractions:</u></b> The children understand the concept of a whole as being one object or one quantity. We will now explore making and recognising equal and unequal parts. They will do this using both real life objects and pictorial representations of a variety of shapes and quantities.</p>
Science	<p><b><u>Rocks:</u></b> In this unit of work pupils will be learning to compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties. We will look at how to describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rocks and recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.</p>
History	<p><b><u>Our local area - Carleton Mill:</u></b> This half term Year 3 will find out more about the history of Carleton and in particular Carleton Mill. We will look at the timeline of the Mill, from its start as a cotton mill to how we know it today. We are hoping to have a visit from a special guest who will be able to tell us more about the history of the village and the Mill.</p>
D.T	<p><b><u>Healthy and varied diet :</u></b> Year 3 will be learning about what makes a healthy diet and more about the different food groups. They will then have a chance to investigate sandwiches and the different components needed to make a healthy sandwich. This will result in the children designing and making their own healthy sandwich.</p>
RE	<p><b><u>What are the deeper meanings of festivals?:</u></b> This half term's unit will introduce Year 3 to different world religions and their major festivals. In particular the children will learn about the Muslim festival Eid-ul-Fitr, the Sikh festival Vaisakhi and the Christian festival Easter. We will look at the deeper meanings of these festivals and the children will make links between the beliefs and practices studied and the role of festivals in the life of Britain today.</p>
P.E.	<p><b><u>Striking &amp; Fielding:</u></b> in this unit we aim to develop, master and apply the basic skills and hand-eye coordination when controlling an object (1/2 hand strike for power). To link basic movements together to make sequences of movement (E.g. moving and striking) and to play competitive games with others and use basic tactics for attacking and defending</p>
Music	<p><b><u>The Dragon Song:</u></b> The children will continue to develop their understanding of pulse, rhythm and pitch through musical games. We will be using the glockenspiel again this half</p>

	term to accompany The Dragon Song using notes G A and B, both improvising and composing their own music.
<b>P.S.H.E</b>	<b>Healthy Me:</b> being and keeping safe and healthy. In this unit we will look at how exercise affects the body and the impact of eating too much sugar and saturated fats on health. We will explore the children's knowledge and attitude towards drugs and how we recognise feeling safe/unsafe.
<b>Computing</b>	<b>Email:</b> the children will learn about using Email as a communication tool. We will be looking at how to use email safely, add attachments and tackle a variety of Email simulations.
<b>French</b>	<b>Core units:</b> This half term Year 3 will be revisiting some of the core units in French such as numbers, days of the week and the family.
