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Year 1 Spring Term 1 Curriculum Map 2022

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	<p><u>Narrative:</u> We will be looking at the story 'Wombat goes Walkabout' by Michael Morpurgo. We will be finding out about different Australian animals and reading the story together. The children will then write their own independent story using ideas from the book to help them.</p> <p><u>Non -Fiction</u> – The children will be looking at a Travel Journal about the Antarctic. They will then write a simple travel journal about a place of interest.</p>
Maths	<p><u>Addition and Subtraction within 20</u> Pupils will be adding by counting on. They will also be finding and making number bonds to 20. We will be using our number bonds to help us solve addition and subtraction problems.</p> <p><u>Place Value within 50</u> The children will be counting to 50 and representing numbers to 50. They will also be looking at one more or less than a number within 50. We will look at ordering number within 50. We will also be counting in 2's and 5's.</p>
Science	<p><u>Uses of Everyday Materials</u> In this unit of work pupils will be able to distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made, identify, and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock, describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials and compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties</p>
Geography	<p><u>Where in the world do these people live?</u> In this unit, children take four different world journeys. Starting with their local area, they then look at coastal, rainforest, dry (desert) and world city locations. They will compare places to the UK and learn about the different styles of housing and jobs people do in different locations.</p>
Art	<p><u>Drawing Projects</u> Pupils will be developing their sketching skills to draw spirals using a variety of media (pencils, charcoal etc) exploring colour and shape. Once they have become confident in their new skill they will move to observe and take inspiration from snails to create their own spiral snail artwork.</p>
Music	<p><u>Glockenspiel</u> Children will be learning to play the Glockenspiel, including learning the names of notes and how they are shown as musical notes. They will learn to play a variety of songs with increasing confidence and learn to vary how loud or soft the notes are.</p>
P.E.	<p><u>Dance</u> This half term, Year One will use dance to explore a musical stimulus. Pupils will work independently or with a partner on occasion to create their own sequences of movement expressing the music. They will work with others to perform and evaluate a dance sequence and will learn about the importance of control and coordination.</p>
R.E.	<p><u>Who am I? What does it mean to belong?</u> This unit of work will enable pupils to know that loving others is important in lots of communities and can identify what Christians and Jews are taught about loving other people. They will explore sense of belonging and different ceremonies that welcome people into communities.</p>
P.S.H. E	<p><u>Dreams and Goals</u> Pupils will learn how to stay motivated when doing something challenging and persevere to succeed. They will set achievable goals that challenge them and keep a positive attitude while working towards their goals.</p>
Computing	<p><u>Coding</u> In this unit pupils will learn to use the computer program 2code, using blocks to give instructions. They will develop an understanding of objects, actions and events and use this to help code successfully.</p>
