Year 6 Spring Term 2 Curriculum Map 2022

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	<u>In English this half term we will start by looking at balanced arguments.</u> Children will look at the language features of a model text and they will write their own balanced argument about whether animals should be kept in zoos. During this unit they will develop the structure of their writing using clear paragraphs, cohesive devices and formal language. We will then move onto reading the book Hugo Cabaret by Brian Selznick. In this unit children will develop their suspense writing and write their own gripping suspense story.
Maths	<u>In Maths, pupils will continue with their topic on algebra.</u> Children will learn how to solve one and two step equations. They will also move onto finding pairs of values and solving tricky formula problems. Our next topic is measurement and children will look at converting units of measure, comparing metric and imperial units of measure and solving word one and two step word problems. On Fridays we will continue to have our arithmetic session and children will consolidate their understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages.
Science	<u>Materials and their properties</u> In Science, children will be exploring different materials. They will compare and group everyday materials on the basis of their properties. Children will work scientifically to carry out investigations to test the properties of different materials including thermal insulators and electrical conductors. They will move onto looking at reversible and non- reversible changes in different materials.
History	<u>What makes people go on a journey?</u> Children will learn about 5 different journeys which have taken place throughout history. These include: Sir Walter Raleigh, the third class citizens on the Titanic, The Empire Wind Rush and refugees fleeing from war. Throughout this topic they will explore why people went on these journeys and compare the different adventures.
DT	<u>Come dine with me!</u> This term in DT children will be working together to prepare a three course meal! They will research a recipe and plan out their meal to make in school. Each group will be graded for their efforts in true come dine with me style!
Music	<u>Happy</u> Children will learn to sing the song 'Happy' by Pharrell Williams and they will perform their final version to the rest of the school. They will be exploring the beat, rhythm and pitch of the music by singing, clapping and listening to different types of music. Children will then write their own versions of the song and they will also accompany the chorus of the song with the recorder.
P.E.	<u>Swimming</u> This half term, Year 6 will have their swimming lesson on a Tuesday afternoon at Craven Swimming pool. Please ensure your child has their kit with them on this day and a coat. On Fridays, Year 6 will continue to work alongside Skipton Tennis Centre and this half term they will be developing their tennis skills.
R.E.	<u>What matters most to Christians and Humanists?</u> In this unit of work children will explore different views about

	living in harmony and compare the Christian and Humanist viewpoints. They will move onto exploring their own views about living in harmony and discussing moral dilemmas.
P.S.H.E	Healthy Me Pupils will learn about healthy food and making healthy choices. They will talk about things that make them feel relaxed and stressed and will understand the difference between being healthy and unhealthy. They will find out that germs cause illness and that all household products, including medicines, can be harmful if not used properly.
Computing	Blogging pupils will continue with their unit of work on creating their own blogs. We will link this work to our history topic about journeys. Children will write their own blog and be able to insert picture and videos.
French	In French this half term children will be learning new vocabulary for their hobbies and likes and dislikes.
