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## Year 2 Spring Term 2 Curriculum Map 2022

Curriculum	Topics
Area	
English	Non-Chronological Reports Pupils will be reading and exploring a non-chronological report all about Pirates. Through the
	report, they will investigate the structure and the key grammatical features of a non-chronological report such as verbs,
	conjunctions and commands. Pupils will then use the structure from shared writing to write their own non-chronological
	report.
Maths	In Maths we will be looking at the areas of Fractions and Length. Within these topics, pupils work on skills such as making
	equal parts, recognising a half and a quarter and comparing and ordering different lengths. Pupils will continue to work or
	their personal key instant recall facts which will help to improve their mental calculations. It is important that they learn and
	practise this target at home each week as part of their Maths homework. Pupils will continue to be assessed on their target
	every other <u>Thursday</u> in class. Please support your child with this routine by ensuring their KIRF book is ready available in
	their reading bags.
Science	<u>Seasonal Changes</u> Pupils will continue to observe the changes across the four seasons. They will complete practical
	investigative work to explore what is happening to our weather and wildlife as we enter the season of spring. Pupils will use
	secondary sources to research the term migration and will also find out how in the UK the day length differs throughout the
	year.
History	The Greatest Explorers- Captain James Cook. Pupils will be focusing on the life and achievements of Captain James Cook. They will begin by finding out about his early life, his passion to be at sea and his three main voyages. They will then investigate his first exploration in depth and how he discovered the east coast of Australia. Lastly, they will thin about why Cook was so special and how he helped others.
DT	<u>Food</u> Pupils will extend their knowledge of different food groups and will experience different foods through taste and smell. They will learn what hidden sugars are and where to find nutritional information on food packaging. They will then design, make and evaluate their own healthy wrap.
Music	<b>Zootime</b> Pupils will be learning a reggae song called 'Zootime'. Pupils will be playing musical games whilst learning about key
	dimensions of music such as pitch and rhythm.
P.E.	Bat and Racquet skills This half term, Year Two will continue to have their PE lessons on Mondays and Fridays. Pupils will
	work on developing and mastering their bat and racquet skills. During each lesson, pupils will participate in a series of team
	games and competitive activities. Through these tasks, they will work on using their hand-eye coordination when controlling a
	racquet/ bat and ball and striking for both power and accuracy.
R.E.	Why does Easter matter to Christians? In this unit of work pupils will recognise that God, Incarnation, Gospel and Salvation
	are part of the 'big story' of the Bible. They will tell stories of Holy Week and Easter and make a link with the idea of Salvation

	(Jesus rescuing people). They will find out how Christians show their beliefs about Jesus as saviour in Church worship and will
	think, talk and ask questions about the idea of forgiveness.
P.S.H.E	Healthy Me Pupils will learn about healthy food and making healthy choices. They will talk about things that make them feel
	relaxed and stressed and will understand the difference between being healthy and unhealthy. They will find out that germs
	cause illness and that all household products, including medicines, can be harmful if not used properly.
Computing	Effective Searching Pupils be looking at the internet, web browsers and search engines. They will learn how to use the
	internet to search for information effectively by exploring the main pages and buttons they will encounter while using search
	engines.
