Year 1 Spring Term 2 Curriculum Map 2022

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	<u>Narrative Writing</u> Pupils will be reading 'The Way Back Home by Oliver Jeffers'. Through this, they will investigate sentences which will include adjectives, onomatopoeia, dialogue, and questions. Pupils will then use the structure from shared writing to write their own narrative.
Maths	In Maths we will be looking at the areas of Length/ Height and Weight/Volume. Within these topics, pupils work on skills such as comparing Length/Height/Mass and measuring different lengths and capacities. Pupils will continue to work on their personal key instant recall facts which will help to improve their mental calculations. It is important that they learn and practise this target at home each week as part of their Maths homework. Pupils will continue to be assessed on their target every other Friday in class. Please support your child with this routine by ensuring their KIRF book is ready available in their reading bags.
Science	<u>Seasonal Changes</u> Pupils will continue to observe the changes across the four seasons. They will complete practical investigative work to explore what is happening to our weather and wildlife as we enter the season of spring.
History	<u>Who were the Greatest Explorers?</u> Pupils will be focusing on the lives and journeys of different explorers. The focus will be on the local hero William Cecil Slingsby. They will be looking at different types of historical evidence to find things out about him and why he is regarded as a local hero.
DT	<u>Structures</u> Pupils will look at structures this half term in DT. They will explore how to make a model windmill. They will design and evaluate their own model.
Music	<u>In the Groove</u> Pupils will be learning a song called 'In the Groove'. Pupils will be playing musical games whilst learning about key dimensions of music such as pitch and rhythm.
P.E.	<u>Striking and Catching skills</u> This half term, Year One will continue to have their PE lessons on Mondays and Wednesdays . Pupils will work on developing and mastering their bat and racquet skills. During each lesson, pupils will participate in a series of team games and competitive activities. Through these tasks, they will work on using their hand-eye coordination when controlling a racquet/ bat and ball and striking for both power and accuracy.
R.E.	<u>Why do Christians put a cross in an Easter Garden?</u> In this unit of work pupils will learn about what the Bible says about Jesus' ministry and the events from Palm Sunday to Easter. They will think about how we help each other when we need to and link this to the story of the Good Samaritan. Symbols of Easter will be explored and how Easter is celebrated by Christians.
P.S.H.E	<u>Healthy Me</u> Pupils will learn about healthy food and making healthy choices. They will find out the importance of keeping clean and learn that germs cause illness. They will also learn that all household products, including medicines, can be harmful if not used properly. We will also be looking at road safety and who can help keep us safe.

Computing

Technology outside of school Pupils be investigating what is meant by technology and can identify a variety of examples both in and out of school. They will have a good understanding about the technological devices in use in their daily lives and how some of these facilitate communication of a variety of formats.
