### **Year 1 Summer Term 1 Curriculum Map 2022**

Curriculum Area	Topics
<b>English</b>	<b><u>Narrative Writing</u></b> Pupils will be reading 'Grandad's Island' by Benji Davies. Through this, they will investigate sentences which will include adjectives, onomatopoeia, dialogue, and questions. Pupils will then use the structure from shared writing to write their own narrative.
<b>Maths</b>	In Maths we will be looking at the areas of multiplication/division and fractions. Pupils will continue to work on their personal key instant recall facts which will help to improve their mental calculations. It is important that they learn and practise this target at home each week as part of their Maths homework. Pupils will continue to be assessed on their target every other <b>Friday</b> in class. Please support your child with this routine by ensuring their KIRF book is readily available in their reading bags.
<b>Science</b>	<b><u>Plants</u></b> Pupils will investigate the different parts of plants and the conditions needed in order for plants to grow. Pupils will complete practical experiments to find out how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.
<b>Geography</b>	<b><u>Where do our favourite animals live?</u></b> Pupils will learn about the different continents and the human and physical characteristics of them. They will find out about a variety of animals including pandas, penguins, sharks and elephants.
<b>ART</b>	<b><u>Art and Design skills</u></b> Developing drawing, design, craft and art appreciation skills; exploring two different printing techniques, using 2D shapes to explore a variety of media, mixing different shades of one colour and discussing the work of artist Louis Wain
<b>Music</b>	<b><u>Round and Round</u></b> Pupils will learn to sing a song, listen to a variety of different styles of music, play parts of the song on the glockenspiel and perform as a class.
<b>P.E.</b>	<b><u>Balance and co-ordination</u></b> This half term, Year One will continue to have their PE lessons on <b>Mondays and Thursdays</b> . Pupils will work on developing their balance, coordination, strength and flexibility.
<b>R.E.</b>	<b><u>How and why do we celebrate sacred and special times?</u></b> Pupils will learn about different festivals, what happens during them and how they are important to people of different religions.
<b>P.S.H.E</b>	<b><u>Relationships</u></b> The children will talk about their families and who is special to them. They will also talk about friendships and how we can be a good friend. The children will also look at special people in school who help them.
<b>Computing</b>	<b><u>Spreadsheets</u></b> The children will navigate around a spreadsheet. They will find out what rows and columns are and how to save and open sheets.
