### **Year 5 Summer Term 1 Curriculum Map 2022**

Curriculum Area	Topics
<b>English</b>	<b><u>Narrative</u></b> Pupils will be reading <b>The Explorer by Katherine Rundell</b> . Through this, they will investigate a range of sentence structures which will include similes, metaphors and complex sentences. Pupils will then use these structures to write their own narrative.
<b>Maths</b>	In Maths, we will be looking at <b>Decimals</b> . Within this, they will learn to add and subtract decimals within one, add and subtract decimals with the same amount of decimal places and look at decimal sequences. Pupils will continue to work on their personal key instant recall facts which will help to improve their mental calculations. It is important that they learn and is important that they learn and practise this target at home each week as part of their Maths homework. Pupils will continue to be assessed on their targets in class. Please support your child with this routine by ensuring their KIRF target booklet and Timetables card are available in their reading bags.
<b>Science</b>	<b>Plants</b> -In this topic, pupils will learn how seed dispersal ensures that new plants survive. They will conduct an experiment looking at the growth of plants and how nutrients are taken through plant growth.
<b>Geography</b>	<b>Journeys: Trade-Where does all of our stuff come from?</b> In this unit, the children will find out about the UK's global trade links, investigating where everyday products come from and the journeys they take to our homes. The children will also map the journeys taken by items, and research the pros and cons of buying local or imported goods
<b>Art</b>	Pupils will look at a range of Artists and learn to interpret the meaning behind their work. They will develop then develop a range of painting and drawing skills to develop their own pieces.
<b>Music</b>	This unit of Work is focused around one song: Fresh Prince of Bel Air. The material presents an integrated approach to music where games, elements of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc), singing and playing instruments are all linked. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise other associated songs of from this range.
<b>P.E.</b>	<b><u>Swimming and Athletics</u></b> This half term, Year 5 will have swimming on Tuesdays at the Craven Pool and another PE lesson on Wednesdays. This second lesson, will be <b>Athletics</b> . In this they will learn sprint, jumping and throwing techniques.
<b>R.E.</b>	What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today? In this unit the children will connections between Muslim practice of the Five Pillars and their beliefs about God and the Prophet Muhammad. They will learn to describe and reflect on the significance of the Holy Qur'an to Muslims.
<b>P.S.H.E</b>	<b><u>Relationships</u></b> - In this unit the children will explore who they are as a person in terms of my characteristics and personal qualities. They will also understand that belonging to an online community can have positive and negative consequences.
<b>Computing</b>	In this unit the children will study the Game Creator Programs – <b>2DIY 3D</b> and begin to plan their own game
<b>French</b>	Children will continue to practise and recall the vocabulary they have already learned in French. They will also learn how to describe the parts of their body and how to count up to 31. They will learn to describe items of clothing and will recap the months of the year. They will finish by reading and translating a story about a birthday party.
