

**Carleton Endowed CE (VA) Primary School**  
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Below is an outline of the work to be covered over the next half term (Autumn 1 2021) in Year 1

Subject	Topics
Literacy	<b>Fiction:</b> This half term we will be exploring adventure stories based on the story of 'The Queen's Hat' by Steve Anthony set in London. <b>Non-fiction:</b> We will be writing labels, lists and captions. <b>Phonics:</b> We will continue to have our daily phonics lessons to support reading and spelling. <b>Handwriting:</b> We will continue to have our daily handwriting lessons to introduce the continuous cursive script used through the school.
Numeracy	This half term, pupils will be exploring <b>Number and place value within 10 moving on to Addition and Subtraction within 10.</b> Pupils will work on their personal key instant recall facts, which will improve their mental calculations and support the Numeracy work they are focusing on in school. It is important that pupils learn and practice these targets at home each week as part of their Numeracy homework. Pupils will be assessed on their targets frequently, in class.
Science	<b>Animals including Humans:</b> In this topic pupils will learn about different types of animals and their basic needs. They will identify and name fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals and recognise whether they are carnivores, herbivores or omnivores. Pupils will also learn to name the parts of the body.
R.E.	<b>Who Made the World?</b> Pupils will retell the story of creation from Genesis 1:1–2.3. They will recognise that 'Creation' is the beginning of the 'big story' of the Bible. Pupils will explore what the story tells Christians about God, Creation and the world. Pupils will give examples of what Christians do to say thank you to God for the Creation. They will think, talk and ask questions about living in an amazing world.
Music	<b>How Can We Make Friends When We Sing Together?</b> We will be learning about rhythm and rhyme while making music on the theme of 'Me'.
P.E.	<b>Multiskills:</b> The sessions will have a focus on individual work and co-operative teamwork. This half term we will be learning the skills of - Throwing, Catching and running. <b>Healthy Lifestyle - Protein &amp; Carbohydrates. Positive Mind Management - Resilience</b>
Geography	<b>Our Local Area:</b> We will be exploring our local area of Carleton. We will talk about the local places of interest and learn about the human and physical features of our village.
Computing	This half term will begin with online safety moving on to grouping and sorting using an online program.
PSHCE	<b>Being Me in My World: Through this topic we will be exploring</b> feeling special and safe, being part of a class, rights and responsibilities, rewards and feeling proud, consequences, owning the Learning Charter and managing feelings.
Art/DT	In art this half term we will be using a variety of media and discovering charcoal like a caveman. Following this we will use wax resist to depict autumn leaves and use squiggle drawings and autumn floor drawings.
