### Year 3 Spring Term 1 Curriculum Map 2022

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	<p><b><u>Narrative: The Flood by Alvaro F. Villa</u></b> using this beautiful wordless picture book we are going to build together the story of the impact of the flood on the family and their home. The children close each unit with an independent write - we will be looking at and writing the story from a different character's perspective.</p> <p><b><u>Non Fiction: Explanation</u></b> using the Oscar winning short film 'Mr Hublot' as our stimulus we are going to construct an explanation text about how a robot dog works. The children will then do an independent write where they compile their own explanation text about another robotic animal.</p>
Maths	<p><b><u>Multiplication &amp; Division:</u></b> this unit is carried over from the Autumn term and the second part of this learning block is looking at multiplying and dividing a two digit number by one digit.</p> <p><b><u>Money:</u></b> we will be counting in pounds and pence as well as adding up and subtracting with money.</p> <p><b><u>Statistics:</u></b> the children will make tally charts, draw pictograms and interpret them. We then move onto tables and bar charts.</p>
Science	<p><b><u>Electricity</u></b> In this unit of work pupils will be looking at identifying appliances that run on mains electricity/battery/both. Exploring and constructing simple circuits using bulbs as well as buzzers and looking at the impact of an open or closed switch to a circuit. We will also investigate conductors and insulators to see which materials are the most effective.</p>
Geography	<p><b><u>Climate and Weather:</u></b> this half term Year 3 will be looking at climate and weather around the world. They will be able to locate some of the world's climate zones on a globe or map, name examples and have some understanding of them. They will extract geographical data (e.g. rainfall, temperature, weather, climate/ vegetation zones) from pictorial/ graphical representations and they will be able to describe and give examples of the variety of biomes and vegetation belts.</p>
Art	<p><b><u>Typography for children :</u></b> This term in Art Year 3 the children will be introduced to the art of typography. They will explore the creation of the letters of a typeface in an intuitive and fun way. They will develop their experience using different grades of pencil to draw different forms and shapes.</p>
RE	<p><b><u>What it means to be a Sikh in Britain today:</u></b> This half term's unit will introduce Year 3 to the Sikh religion in a clear and straightforward way, taking account of the history, current practice and beliefs of the Sikhs in Britain today. It will give the children a chance to learn from some Sikh stories, ideas and concepts and to develop their own appreciation of Sikh religion.</p>
P.E.	<p><b><u>Dance:</u></b> This half term we will be using some great stimuli and music to motivate the children to get moving. They will compose dances in pairs/small groups, learning to consider dynamics, space and relationships.</p>
Music	<p><b><u>Learning The Glockenspiel:</u></b> The children will be learning to play the Glockenspiel, including learning the names of notes and how they are shown as musical notes. They will learn to play a variety of songs with increasing independence, and to play notes of different lengths.</p>
P.S.H.E	<p><b><u>Dreams &amp; Goals:</u></b> Aspirations, how to achieve goals and understanding the emotions that go with this</p> <p>In this unit the children will be looking at different strategies to help them achieve their dreams and</p>

	goals. How to stay motivated when faced with challenges, and coping with setbacks. We will learn how we help and support others to reach their goals and recognise others achievements.
<b>Computing</b>	<b>Spreadsheets</b> the children will learn to create a table of data on a spreadsheet and can use this to automatically create charts/graphs from data. They will look at how to select the most suitable type of chart to use for their data, edit headers and apply axis labels. This unit has a strong mathematical element to it and we explore number lines, 'more than', 'less than' and 'equal' tools. As well as collect and enter data and to use the graphing tool to create suitable graphical representations of the data they have within a table
<b>French</b>	<b>La Jungle:</b> This half term Year 3 will learn how to read and spell animal names in French. We will do this through songs, rhyme, stories and games.
