Year 6 Autumn Term 1 Curriculum Map 2024

Curriculum Area	Topics
English	The Journey Pupils will be using the text 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna to inspire their narrative writing. Pupils will begin by investigating the different plot points in the text. Through their sentence stacking lessons, they will form sentences which include grammatical features such as similes, complex sentences and rhetorical questions. Pupils will use the structure from shared writing to plan and write their own adventure story.
Maths	Place Value and Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division Within our Maths topics this half term, pupils work on skills such as reading and writing numbers to 10,000,000, comparing and ordering any integers, knowing negative numbers and knowledge how to use short and long division.
Science	Animals including humans During this unit of work, children will learn about the importance of the circulatory system and how it transports oxygen around our body. They will learn about the heart and how it is an important muscle in our bodies. Children will learn about their heart rate and different activities that can increase the heart rate. Children will learn about being healthy and things they can do to lead a healthy lifestyle as well as learning about things that people do that can cause them to be unhealthy.
Geography	World War Two Pupils will learn why World War Two began and will understand how empire and rebellion influenced Hitler and his plan to dominate Europe. They will explore the significance of the Battle of Britain and will complete a local study and compare this to the experiences of the inner cities. Moreover, pupils will find how Britain gained victory in World War Two.
Art	Photo Opportunity Pupils will have the opportunity to explore creative photographic techniques, create new images through photomontage and apply digital photography to art design. They will use work such as The Scream by Edvard Munch to inspire their work.
Music	Recorder Pupils will be learning to play the recorder, including learning the names of notes and how they are shown as musical notes. They will learn to play a variety of songs with increasing independence, and to play notes of different lengths.
P.E	Fitness Pupils will have P.E lessons on a Monday and Wednesday . Through their Fitness unit, pupils will take part in a range of activities that explore and develop different areas of their health and fitness. They will learn different components of fitness including speed, stamina, strength, co-ordination, balance and agility. Pupils will be given opportunities to work at their maximum and improve on their personal fitness levels. They will work on persevering when they get tired or when they find a challenge hard and will be encouraged to support others to do the same.
R.E	What would Jesus do? Pupils will be focusing some of the teachings of Jesus through his sermons and parables. They will work on considering a Christian understanding of what God is like and what Jesus' teachings might teach Christians about how to live. Pupils will also express their own understanding of what Jesus would do in relation to some moral dilemmas from the world today.
P.S.H.E	Being me in my world Within this unit of work, pupils will start by considering what it means to feel valued and how they can make others feel the same. They will identify their goals for the year ahead as well as any worries they may have and will discuss how to express these feelings. Pupils will also consider their rights and responsibilities. They will explore the universal rights for children and will learn that these rights are not met for all children. Finally, pupils will consider the concept of democracy and will understand how they can contribute towards the democratic process.
Computing	Coding Pupils will use the Purple Mash program 2Code to study coding. They will use coding to create their own playable game with a timer and a score and will also learn how to make their programming more efficient.
French	Core Unit Pupils will spend time this half term recapping basic French vocabulary including numbers, colours, parts of the body and months of the year. They will also work on revising key phrases such as saying simple greetings, asking basic questions and responding to instructions.
